This is not just a tour—it's an adventure that takes you through the heart of Japan, filled with stories, flavours, and experiences you will never forget.



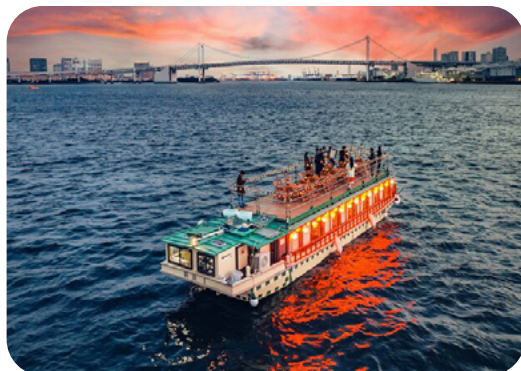
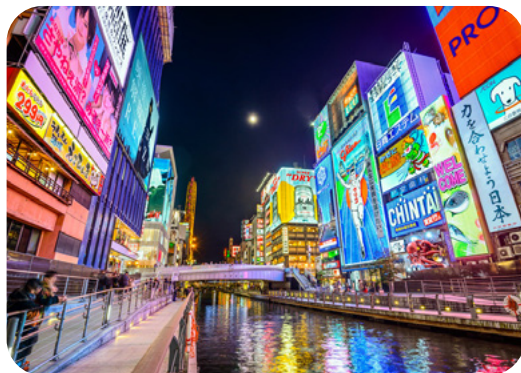
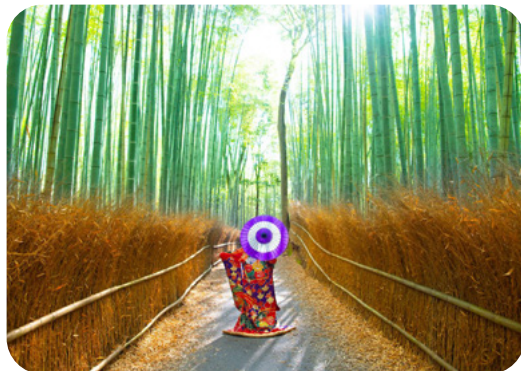

Today is the day we have all been waiting for – Japan, here we come! Meet the Leef Jou Reis team at OR Tambo Airport and depart on an unforgettable adventure.

## DAY 2: 26 September 2026

Welcome to Japan! Our adventure begins in the dynamic city of Osaka, known as the “kitchen of Japan” thanks to its world-famous food culture and lively atmosphere. From the airport, we will be transferred by luxury bus to our centrally located hotel, for easy access to the main attractions. After checking in, we will take a little time to settle in before gathering for a warm and festive welcome dinner. Here, we will taste our very first flavours of Japan and raise a glass to the exciting journey ahead – the perfect start to get to know the group better and look forward to the unforgettable experiences that await.

## DAY 3: 27 September 2026

After breakfast at the hotel, we meet our local guide who will take us on a journey of discovery through Osaka.

The day begins with a visit to the iconic **Osaka Castle**, an impressive 16th-century fortress that played a key role in Japan’s unification history. Inside the castle, there is a museum where you can learn more about the Samurai era and the city’s rich heritage.

Afterwards, you will have the chance to explore the vibrant **Dotonbori district** on your own. This colourful neighbourhood, famous for its neon lights, street food and the famous **Glico man billboard**, is one of Osaka’s most beloved hangout spots.



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In the afternoon, we will take part in a hands-on **Okonomiyaki cooking class**. This savoury pancake, often called “Osaka’s favourite dish,” is made with a mix of cabbage, meat or seafood and topped with a unique sauce and mayonnaise – a fun and tasty experience to try for yourself.

Late afternoon, we will visit the futuristic **Umeda Sky Building**, one of Osaka’s modern landmarks. Its observation deck, the Floating Garden Observatory, offers panoramic views over the city—especially breathtaking at sunset.

The evening is free for your own exploration. You can seek out a cozy restaurant or street food stall and enjoy even more of Osaka’s incredible food culture.

## DAY 4: 28 September 2026

Today we bid farewell to Osaka and continue our journey to the historic city of Kyoto, which served as Japan’s imperial capital for centuries. Along the way, we make a special stop in Nara, the first permanent capital of Japan and a place rich in ancient tradition and beauty.

We visit the famous **Nara Deer Park**, where hundreds of tame deer roam freely – in Shinto belief, they are considered sacred messengers of the gods. After this, we explore the impressive **Tōdai-ji Temple**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to one of the world’s largest bronze Buddha statues.

Next, you will have time to stroll through **Naramachi**, the old merchant district of Nara.

This charming neighbourhood, filled with wooden shops, eateries, and traditional houses, is perfect for a relaxed lunch and some discovery at your own pace.

In the afternoon, a truly unforgettable experience awaits: we take part in a traditional Japanese tea ceremony, where you will witness the art and symbolism of this centuries-old ritual firsthand. To make it even more special, we will wear authentic **Japanese kimonos** – an experience that transports you back to the elegance of old Kyoto.

After this highlight, we continue to our hotel in Kyoto and check in. The evening holds a special dinner at **Gankō Takasegawa Nijoen**, a restaurant renowned for its refined Kaiseki cuisine and beautiful setting. While we enjoy the dishes, we are treated to a Maiko performance – a unique chance to witness the elegance and grace of an apprentice geisha up close.

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## DAY 5: 29 September 2026

After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, it is time to discover more of Kyoto's beauty. We meet our guide, who leads us through a day of cultural highlights and breathtaking sights.

Our first stop is the shimmering **Kinkaku-ji**, also known as the Golden Pavilion. This Zen temple, covered in gold leaf and reflected in the serene pond that surrounds it, is one of Kyoto's most iconic landmarks and a true symbol of elegance and tranquillity.

We then visit **Tenryū-ji Temple**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site built in the 14th century, famous for its stunning Zen gardens. From here, we walk into the enchanting **Arashiyama Bamboo Grove**, a magical place where towering bamboo stalks surround you and create the feeling of stepping into another world.

To end our Arashiyama exploration, we board a traditional rickshaw, taking us through the quiet streets and offering a unique glimpse of this historic district.

The afternoon is yours to explore at leisure at **Nishiki Market**. This centuries-old food market, often called the “kitchen of Kyoto,” offers an incredible variety of local products, spices and street food – perfect for sampling and discovery.

Later in the afternoon, we return to the hotel. The evening is free for your own exploration – choose a cozy restaurant or discover a bit more of Kyoto's enchanting nightlife.

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## DAY 6: 30 September 2026

This morning, a brand-new adventure awaits us. Our luggage will be sent directly to our Tokyo hotel, so we only travel with our overnight bags. We board the **famous bullet train** – a fast and modern way to admire Japan's beautiful landscapes – heading towards Hakone, known for its stunning scenery and hot springs.

Our **Hakone** adventure begins with a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, where you will taste the flavours of the region and soak up the area's atmosphere.

After lunch, we cruise across the serene waters of **Lake Ashi**, surrounded by magnificent mountains and if the weather allows, offering a glimpse of the majestic **Mount Fuji** in the background. Next, we take a cable car ride up to **Owakudani**, a volcanic valley known for its steaming vents and unique hot springs – a true natural wonder that showcases the raw power of the earth.

Later, we arrive at our hotel for the evening, beautifully located with views of the surrounding mountains and lake. Here, you can relax and enjoy the onsen (natural hot spring baths) – the perfect way to unwind after another exciting day.

In the evening, we enjoy a peaceful and tasty dinner at the hotel as we prepare for the next phase of our adventure.

## DAY 7: 01 October 2026

This morning after breakfast at the hotel, we depart for Tokyo, Japan's bustling capital, where modern skyscrapers, historic temples, and lively neighborhoods await to be discovered.

In Tokyo, our exploration begins with a visit to the iconic **Asakusa Senso-ji Temple**, one of the city's oldest and most revered Buddhist temples. In front of the temple lies the colourful **Nakamise Street**, lined with traditional shops and stalls where you can discover local treats and handicrafts.

Afterward, we stop by the **Imperial Palace**, the beautiful residence of the Emperor of Japan, to admire its impressive gardens and architecture.



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You will also have free time to wander around the famous **Ginza district** – a world of luxury boutiques, elegant cafés, and stylish street art.

Our day ends in an unforgettable way: a **Yakatabune dinner cruise**, where we sail on a traditional Japanese houseboat and enjoy a delicious meal while the city lights shimmer across the river. A perfect ending to a day full of culture, history, and unique experiences.

## DAY 8: 02 October 2026

Another exciting day of discovery in Tokyo awaits us today. We begin with a hands-on **sushi-making class**, where we learn the art of preparing this iconic Japanese dish – from working with fresh fish to perfecting the roll of the rice. A delicious and fun experience, especially for culinary enthusiasts.



After the class, we dive into Japan's rich culture at the **Tokyo National Museum**, one of the oldest and most comprehensive national museums in the world. Here, we can admire the history, art, and traditions of Japan up close.

Our day continues with a visit to the **Meiji Jingu Shrine**, a tranquil Shinto sanctuary surrounded by dense forest in the heart of the city – offering peace and serenity amidst Tokyo's vibrant energy. From here, we explore the city's fashion icons: **Harajuku**, famous for its colourful street fashion and youth culture, and **Omotesando**, an elegant avenue filled with luxury stores and striking modern architecture.
